Battery cabinet circuit breaker in the computer room



Overview

What is a battery cabinet?

The battery cabinet is installed in a standalone configuration. The term standalone refers to battery cabinets that may be installed adjacent to the UPS or in a separate location, are wired with external customer-supplied conduit and wiring, and may use the battery cabinet breaker as the battery isolation device or a switch.

What are the different types of UPS circuit breaker options?

UPS circuit breaker options include auxiliary contacts, undervoltage release (UVR) and shunt trip circuit breakers. All battery cabinets ship factory assembled and fully tested. Arimon front access battery cabinets are designed for easy maintenance with full front access for safety.

What is a battery cabinet (IBC) system?

Battery Cabinet (IBC) systems are housed in single free-standing cabinets. Model IBC-L with a single battery voltage range is available to meet application runtime needs. Up to four cabinets may be installed to further extend battery runtimes. The cabinets match the UPS cabinet in style.

Where is the battery cabinet located?

The location for the battery cabinet is on the right side of the UPS cabinet. This location will allow for future expansion using an external module. Cabinets can be permanently bolted to the floor or left standing on leveling feet. Power and control wiring can be routed through the top or bottom of the cabinet depending on installation.

How do I set up an UPS battery room?

Open-rack battery rooms must be adjacent to the UPS room. Battery cabinets must be adjacent to the UPS equipment. Cable lengths from multiple cabinets should be kept as nearly identical as possible to prevent voltage drop.

variations. One cabinet should be able to hold at least one complete string of cells.

Can a battery be installed in a computer room?

Sometimes they are installed in the same room as the UPS (i.e., electrical equipment room). Local or regional codes may dictate whether batteries are permitted in an electrical room. Smaller UPS systems (e.g, up to 250 kVA) are commonly installed directly in the computer room along with their respective battery cabinets.
