Columbia Power Base Station Announced



Overview

Columbia Generating Station is a nuclear commercial energy facility located on the , 10 miles (16 km) north of . It is owned and operated by , a Washington state, not-for-profit joint operating agency. Licensed by the in 1983, Columbia first produced electricity in May 1984, and entered commercial operation in Decem.

The Bonneville Power Administration has given the go-ahead to a USD700 million project which, together with planned energy efficiency upgrades, will add a total 186 MWe of capacity to the only operating nuclear power plant in the USA's Pacific Northwest region by 2031.
