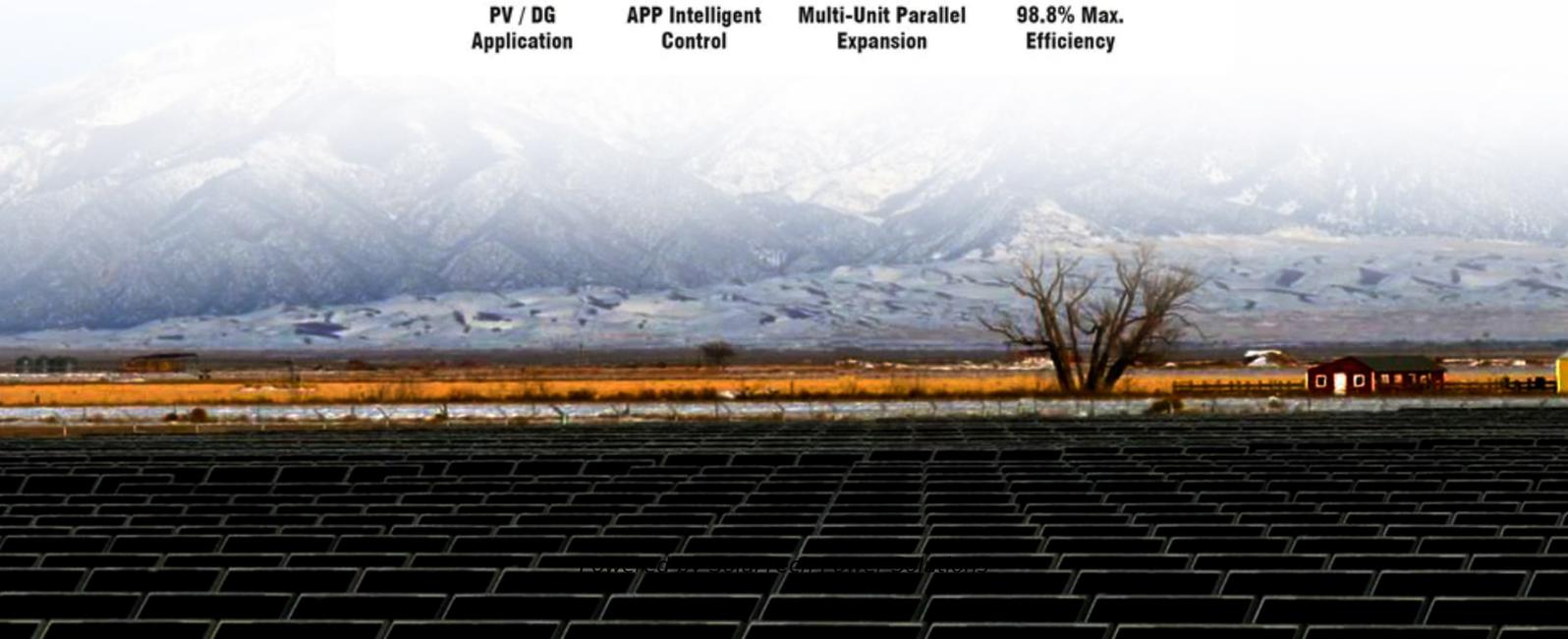

Overview

Te Mana Uira o Araura (TMU) is a critical key infrastructure asset for Aitutaki (formerly Aitutaki Power Supply Limited). What type of plug does Cook Islands use?

Cook Islands uses power outlets and plugs of type I. Take a look at the picture below to see what this plug and power socket looks like: Doesn't look familiar?

Do the outlets look different in your country?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type I - Used in Australia, New Zealand, the South Pacific, China and Argentina.

Do power plugs work in Cook Islands?

Cook Islands uses 240V voltage, 50Hz frequency, plug types: I Will my power plugs work in Cook Islands?

Cook Islands uses Type I electrical outlets with standard voltage of 240V and 50Hz frequency. If your device plugs don't match Cook Islands's standards, we recommend purchasing suitable travel adapters in advance to ensure proper use.

Do I need a power adapter for Cook Islands?

Yes, traveling to Cook Islands requires a power plug adapter. Cook Islands uses Type I electrical outlets, which may not be compatible with your device plugs. We recommend purchasing universal adapters that support Type I plugs. Do I need a voltage converter for Cook Islands?

Cook Islands's standard voltage is 240V with 50Hz frequency.

What type of electrical outlets are used in Cook Islands?

In Cook Islands electrical outlets and plugs of type I are used (see images). You can check if these are the same as in your country with the tool at the top

of this page. The voltage used in Cook Islands is 240V with a frequency of 50Hz.

Can a universal power adapter fit a Cook Islands outlet?

Universal power adapters usually come with multiple plug types and can be adjusted to fit Cook Islands outlets and many others. If your devices are not compatible with the voltage in your destination country, a voltage converter or transformer will also be necessary to convert the voltage to the appropriate range for your devices.

What is the standard power socket voltage in Cook Islands?

All power sockets in Cook Islands provide a standard voltage of 240V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Cook Islands if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia.
