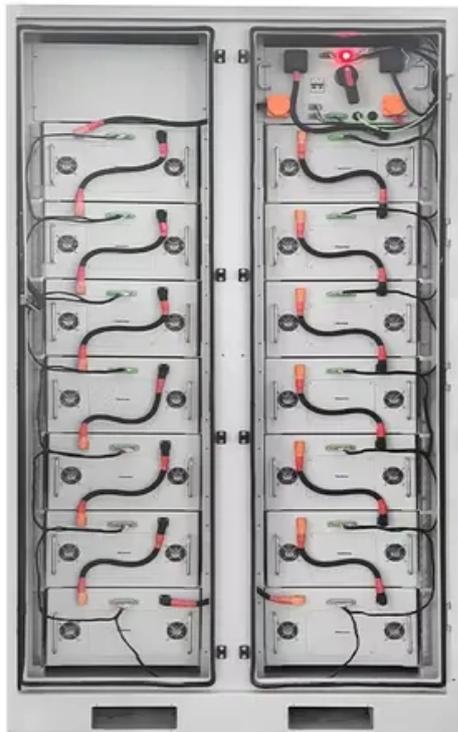


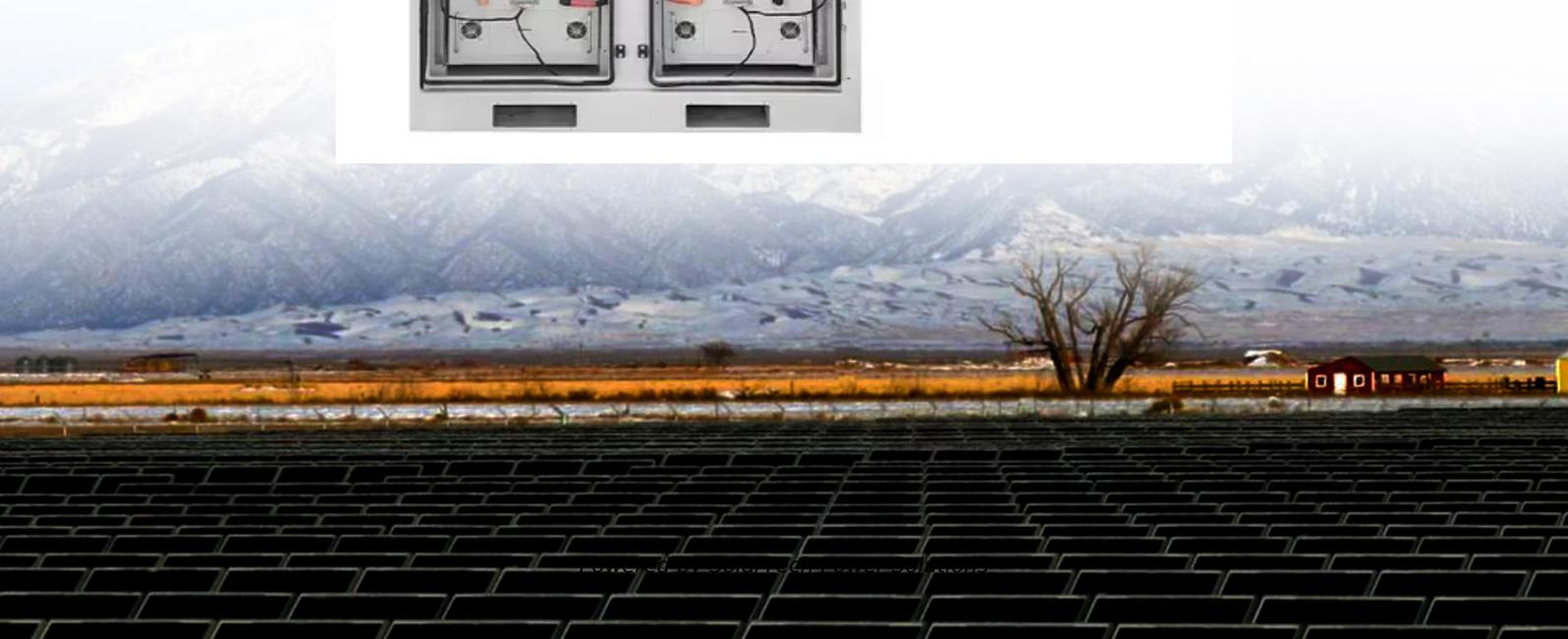

## Overview

Are battery energy storage systems a fire hazard?

As the demand for renewable energy sources escalates, Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) have become pivotal in stabilizing the electrical grid and ensuring a continuous power supply. However, the high-density energy stored in these systems poses significant fire risks, necessitating cutting-edge fire suppression solutions.

How can a battery energy storage system protect against a fire?

For businesses that use battery energy storage systems, there are several proactive steps that can be taken to protect against a fire. This includes three specific methods: One of the primary methods to combat thermal runaway in BESS is through the use of cooling agents.

Are battery energy storage systems economically feasible in Vietnam?

However, in Vietnam, there is a widely held industry perception that Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) are not economically feasible at this moment, while the country's first pumped storage hydropower (PSH) project Bac Ai with a capacity of 1,200 MW will not be commissioned until 20289.

What is battery energy storage fire prevention & mitigation?

In 2019, EPRI began the Battery Energy Storage Fire Prevention and Mitigation - Phase I research project, convened a group of experts, and conducted a series of energy storage site surveys and industry workshops to identify critical research and development (R&D) needs regarding battery safety.

How much money does Vietnam need to build a grid?

According to PDP8, the total investment required for the development of grid from 2021 to 2030 amounts to \$14.9 billion, equivalent to \$1.5 billion per year or 0.4% of Vietnam's GDP in 2020 (Table 1). The strained state budget alone may struggle to accommodate such substantial financial requirements.

## Why is fire a problem in Vietnam?

In recent years, along with impressive economic development and swift urbanization in Vietnam, the number of fires and explosions has significantly increased, particularly at industrial factories and manufacturing facilities, which has caused many injuries and deaths, as well as substantial property damage.
