On February 17th, 2023 (February 16th, Beijing time), the construction of the first phase of the 120 MW Peñasco Port solar power project in Mexico was completed by the Federal Electricity Commission (CFE). The project was equipped with a complete set of energy storage solutions, advanced storage.

Recently, China Power Energy Storage Development Limited (hereinafter referred to as "China Power Energy Storage"), a subsidiary of CPID, synchronized and put into operation the associated energy storage system for Mexico's first government-level solar power project, Puerto Peñasco Photovoltaic.

This is the first government-level photovoltaic + energy storage project in Mexico. We collaborated with CFE (Mexican Federal Electricity Commission) to design and supply the BESS (Battery Energy Storage System) for this project. The project achieved Commercial Operation Date (COD) in April 2023.

Eighty-seven years after the oil expropriation of 1938, another turning point in Mexico's energy history took place on March 18, 2025, when President Claudia Sheinbaum signed sweeping legislative reforms into law that will restructure the country's electricity sector to strengthen energy security.
