Speaking after launching the construction of the project, Minister of Energy, Hon. Ibrahim Matola, commended.

A UK-based charity has installed solar photovoltaic systems in all 9,000 households of a rural village in Malawi, Kasakula. The nonprofit has trained local technicians to maintain the systems — and says it retrieves damaged or retired batteries or other components for now, as no system for safely.
