Overview

How much solar power does Ukraine have in 2024?

Figures from the Solar Energy Association of Ukraine (SEAU) earlier this year showed that the country added around 850MW of solar PV capacity in 2024, the majority of which came from self-consumption systems installed by businesses. It's "become a trend", Semenyshyn says.

Is solar energy gaining traction in Ukraine?

Solar energy in Ukraine is gaining traction. With one of the largest solar energy companies in the country aiming to deliver 1 Gigawatt of solar and wind energy by 2030, there is a huge spike in demand. Ukraine has a range of incentives designed to encourage investment in solar power facilities.

How many solar plants are there in Ukraine?

The 70 solar plants operating in the country have a capacity of 1.79 GW, according to the Russian Renewable Energy Association. The figure doesn't include any capacity acquired since Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Generating capacity in Russian-occupied Ukraine runs to around 950 MW, according to UARE.

Can solar power help Ukraine survive a war?

Solar energy has been essential for survival in Ukraine during nearly three years of war since the Russian invasion in 2022. As citizens hope for peace, PV will be instrumental in supporting post-war recovery, whenever it comes.

How has War impacted Ukraine's solar industry?

From pv magazine 02/25 Nearly three years of war has taken its toll on Ukraine's solar industry. Almost 13% of the country's pre-war solar generation capacity was located in territories now controlled by Russian forces, explained Olga Sukhopara, former director of development at the Ukrainian Association of Renewable Energy (UARE).
