The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) is providing \$142mn (€121mn) in financing for two special-purpose vehicles (SPVs) set to develop Uzbekistan’s and Central Asia’s largest combined solar photovoltaic and battery energy storage project to date. The two SPVs—ACWA Power.

ASTORIOS Holding Inc., a US-based international renewable energy company, announces the launch of Uzbekistan’s largest solar carport, reinforcing the country’s commitment to sustainable energy. In recent years, Uzbekistan has experienced significant growth in solar initiatives, aiming to achieve 7.

Japan’s Sumitomo Corporation, Shikoku Electric Power (Yonden), Chubu Electric Power, and Saudi’s ACWA Power have secured financing agreements to develop Uzbekistan’s largest solar and battery energy storage system (BESS).

comprehensive completion of on-site dynamic compaction. This project is a key.
