Which companies are partnering with 5G in 2025?

January 2025: Nokia secured a USD 2.3 billion contract with Bharti Airtel for 5G radio access across 17 Indian states. December 2024: Ericsson announced a partnership with Microsoft to pair Azure Edge Zones with 5G base stations for ultra-low-latency industrial use cases.

Why is the 5G base station market growing?

The surging demand for high-speed connectivity is a significant factor driving the growth of the 5G base station market. In terms of region, Asia Pacific was the largest revenue generating market in 2023. In terms of segment, hardware accounted for a revenue of USD 33,472.5 million in 2023.

This price includes hardware, installation, site rental, and maintenance. Urban areas often have higher costs due to land prices and infrastructure challenges.

Which 5G base station market dominated the global market in 2023?

The Asia Pacific 5G base station market dominated the global market in 2023 and accounted for 32.67% of the revenue share.
